Research on human remains is a part of a long scientific tradition. Today museums are the custodians of extensive collections and both skeletal remains and soft tissues. In the Humanities and Social Sciences, research on human remains provide valuable information of the lived experience of people in the past. At the same time, reservations are made against research on the remains of people who were never able to consent. Laws and guidelines have been developed to regulate the issue, but these have for the most part been developed to handle the remains from indigenous peoples/minorities, and do not include provisions for all remains. Similarly, medical laws and regulations

do not consider older remains. Researchers who work on these collections therefore find themselves in a relatively unregulated area, which risks undermining the legitimacy of the research. Through a series of comparative studies of practices and guidelines in museums, this project seeks to elucidate how ethical decisions are made and what values inform these decisions.
